

## Guide to install workspace bar

This extension helps to easily switch workspaces by simply clicking on the desired workspace. When it is activated it appears at the center of the Top bar.


1. Open <https://extensions.gnome.org> on your browser.
2. Search for the extension "**workspacebar**"



To control GNOME Shell extensions using this site you must install GNOME Shell integration that consists of two parts: browser extension and native host messaging application. [Click here to install browser extension](#). See [wiki page](#) for native host connector installation instructions.

3. Click on the **Extension Homepage** link



A toolbar for your panel that allows you to switch workspaces. Latest update includes a panel position option of left, center, and right. 
4. Choose the latest **shell version** and **extension version**




5. Choose **Save File** button and Click **OK** to Save the extension on your computer




6. Go to **Applications > Utilities > Tweak tool > Extensions**
